Mill Tour Information: Blue Heron Paper

Located in the historic Oregon City at the falls on the Willamette River, Blue Heron Paper Company is an integrated producer of newsprint and specialty papers utilizing more than 50% recovered fiber. Blue Heron Paper's product mix consists of reNews® newsprint, reBrite® high brightness printing paper, heavyweight printing grades and bad converting grades for the fast food industry.

Recycling at the Oregon City mill has been a focus, starting with a small 25 ton per day plant in 1975. Today we recycle over 500 tons of paper every day. The grades we use are: Newspapers, Magazines, Pressroom overissue, Press stand over issue, Pressroom trimmings, shavings, Sorted residential mixed waste papers, excluding food board and boxboard and Post consumer white papers. Other grades of waste paper are frequently considered. We're looking to the public and business community to partner with us to continue to help the environment.
