Research engineers, scientists, and practitioners are encouraged to submit presentation proposals on all aspects of recycling technologies and operations. Submissions describing both basic and applied research results will be considered.

We are interested in papers describing research on all aspects of paper recycling including, but not limited to:

- Challenges and solutions for recycling in Europe, Asia Pacific, South America, and North America
- Lessons learned and best practices in new recycle facilities in Asia-Pacific
- Raw material management, including bale sampling methods
- Impact of recovered paper quality on production, yield, runnability and paper quality
- Recyclability requirements of paper products
- Deinking digital ink
- Technical issues in recycling fiber for tissue production
- Stickies measurement and control
- Quantification of other contaminants
- Challenges of recycling cardboard and boxboard
- White water contamination, treatment and abatement of contamination
- Process technology developments: pulping, screening, cleaning, flotation and dispersion
- Recycle plant optimization
- Environmental impacts including sludge utilization, land filling, and water management
- New technology and products

The 10th Research Forum on Recycling continues its history of highlighting cutting-edge research results from around the world. This year's event will provide participants an extraordinary opportunity to hear about the latest in recycling research, discuss mill operation issues, network with peers, and identify future research needs of the recycling community.

Abstracts should be 1-2 paragraphs in length. Authors will be notified of acceptance by **28 March 2013** and must provide a full text manuscript by **15 June 2013**.
