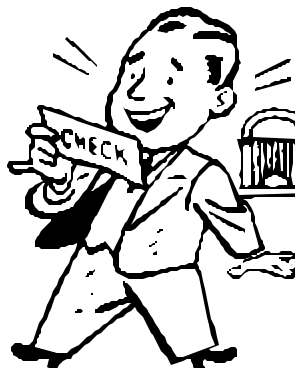
2005 STUDENT SUMMIT
