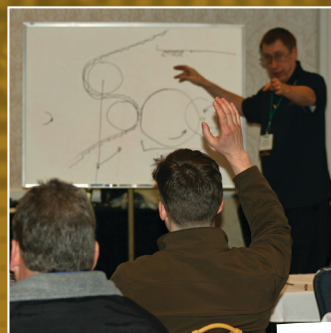

CORRUGATED

TAPPI Corrugated Box & Linerboard Medium Manufacturing Course

With this introductory to intermediate course, attendees can strengthen their understanding of the corrugating process, linerboard and medium performance properties and manufacture.

TAPPI Linerboard/Medium Manufacture Course

Do you need to increase your understanding of linerboard and medium performance properties and manufacturing in order to improve performance and runnability? Core course topics will cover linerboard and medium properties, tests and how these relate to the final box performance.

TAPPI Troubleshooting “Flexos” and Die Cutters” Sustain Board Caliper & Improve Printing Course

Are you looking to identify and address downtime issues? Do you need to develop a better understanding of machine calibration and how to maintain proper board caliper? If you answered yes, then this is the course for you.

PULP & PAPER

TAPPI Improving Paper Machine Performance Course

Improving Paper Machine Performance Course participants will learn how to evaluate the performance of each operation of the paper machine from the stock approach system to the reel. This is a “hands-on” course, which will involve group workshops to measure machine performance. You’ll learn to apply appropriate TAPPI Technical Information Papers (TIPS) and other industry standards to benchmark your paper machine. And, you’ll discover proven methods to optimize paper machine performance through operational improvements.

TAPPI Coating 101 Course

This course targets paper coating professionals who are new to the industry as well as those who have some experience in the business but are now in need of understanding of the basics of the technology. This course should appeal to the commercial workforce desiring a technical base, to new hires with experience in other industries but new to the paper industry, to young professionals either fresh out of college or new to coating, and to professionals who’ve spent their previous years in other parts of the paper industry.

TAPPI Intro to Pulp & Paper Technology Course

The overall course objective is to give participants increased confidence in understanding the pulp & paper processes; to interact more knowledgeably with process engineers and operators; and to increase their ability to contribute to improving mill operations.

TAPPI Paper Machine Operations Course

Overall purpose of course: Provide fundamental training on the design and operation of the paper machine and support systems for operators and other individuals who are involved with the day to day operation of the paper machine.

TAPPI Introduction to Kraft Pulping & Bleaching Course

The overall course objective is to give participants increased understanding of kraft pulp mill operations; awareness of how one part of the process affects other operations; and the effect of processes on kraft pulp quality.

40TH YEAR

TAPPI Kraft Recovery Course

The Kraft Recovery Course examines key recovery operations in a kraft pulp mill to help participants increase their ability to improve pulp production efficiency while minimizing operating costs and environmental problems. The course will cover chemistry, physics and engineering relating to kraft recovery.

TAPPI Introduction to Wet End Chemistry Short Course

Papermakers are striving to improve product quality, increase machine productivity, and reduce costs. This course is designed to facilitate this understanding and provide participants with a foundation upon which to develop effective wet end chemistry trouble shooting and optimization programs for their companies.

TAPPI Linerboard Medium Manufacturing Course

The overall course objective is to increase understanding of linerboard and medium performance properties and manufacturing in order to improve corrugating box performance and runnability. Core course topics will cover linerboard & medium properties & tests and how these relate to the final box performance. For those participants who require an overview background on Papermaking operations, there will be an optional one day Introduction to P&P on Monday, prior to the beginning of the main course on Tuesday.

TAPPI Corrugated Box & Linerboard Medium Manufacturing Course

With this introductory to intermediate course corrugators and pulp and paper mill employees can strengthen their understanding of the corrugating process, and linerboard and medium performance properties and manufacture.

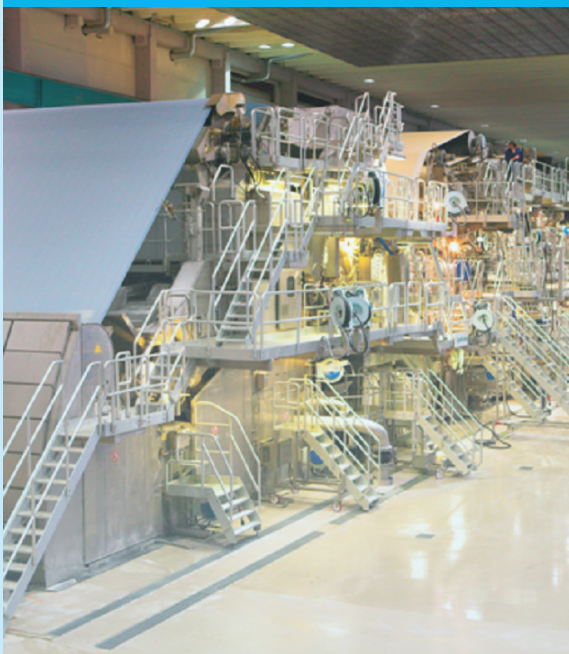
Sustain Board Caliper & Improve Printing Course

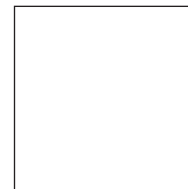
