



TAPPISAFE and the Alliance Safety Council have partnered to bring you the OSHA 10-hour and 30-hour safety courses.

IMPORTANT! Please read the following OSHA Course Guidelines

- You have **180 days** to complete the course. This is a hard deadline, and you will not be able to extend it. You will have to pay for a new course if you miss the deadline and want to complete the course.
- If you fail any module/section (including the introduction) 3 times, the course will immediately stop, and you will have to pay for a new course to start over.
- OSHA 10-hour training must be split into two days. The OSHA 30-hour training will take at least four days to complete. A **mandatory** 8-hour break is required after 7.5 consecutive training hours. After you complete your break, you cannot resume training until the next calendar day.
- If you want to take a break, please log completely out of the course, this ensures that your time does not continue to progress while away.

OSHA Safety Course Step-by-Step Instructions

Step 1

Go to the [TAPPSAFE OSHA Course](#) landing page and click on the button for the OSHA course you would like to take. Once you've selected the course that you would like to take, you will be taken to the login page where you will have the option to log in with your personal or company credentials or continue as a guest.

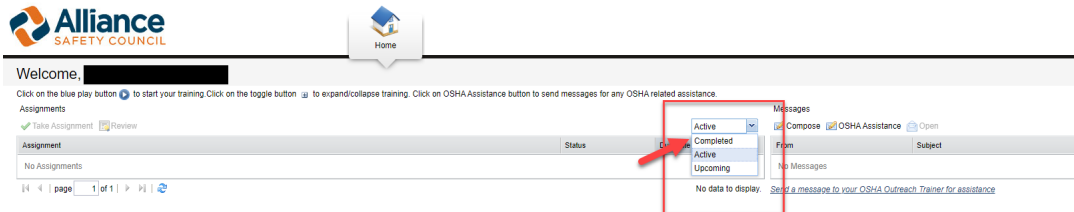

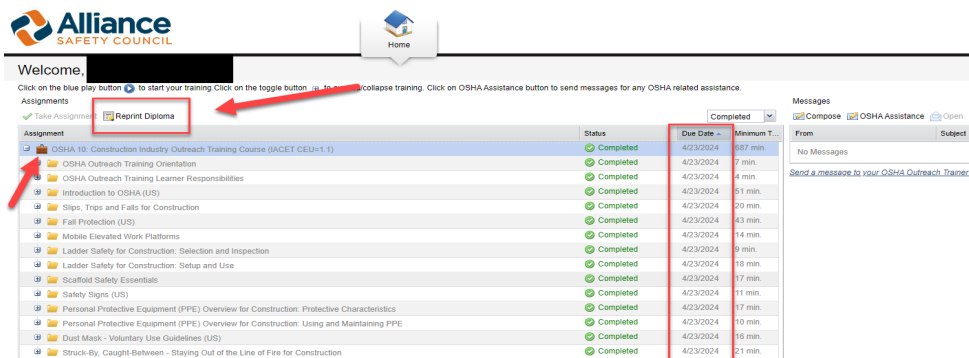

Step 4

Once you pass the OSHA course, you can print your certificate by accessing the welcome screen and changing the drop-down from **ACTIVE** to **COMPLETED**. Once **COMPLETED** is selected, you will also see all of your completed modules/sections.



Next click on the **Briefcase icon** to make the **Reprint Diploma icon** appear. Click on the Reprint Diploma icon to download your diploma onto your device. (If on a computer, it will be in your downloads. If you are on a tablet or cell phone, you will need to review your phone settings to know where it is located post-download.)
